DO NOT BRING: Electronics (radios, tape players, cd/dvd players, mp3 players, handheld games) or aerosol sprays, sheath knives, candy/gum or soft drinks.

Climbing safety and teamwork will be emphasized. We will be requiring each scout to adhere to a code of conduct which does not allow for horseplay at any time during the climbing activity. Should your scout disobey the instructor he will be removed from the activity for the rest of the weekend.

Please understand that to climb over a forty foot tower and rappel back down is physically demanding. By signing this permission slip, you acknowledge that a bruise or bump may be on your son when he returns along with a smile of accomplishment.
