JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Headquarters – Water sales and check-in for assignments. Our Boy Scouts are allowed to sell bottled water at the headquarters tent throughout festival times.

Beer Garden – Adults Only: These adults are asked to make sure that festivalgoers stay within a designated area when drinking alcoholic beverages.

Artists' Breaks/Booth Sitters – Adults Only: During the hours of the festival, our adults walk the grounds looking for vendors who may want to take a break from their booths. The artist's will usually place a sign on the booth when they need a break, but you may also identify yourself and ask if they need to take a break or assist them in other ways as well.

Load-In/Load-Out – Adults and Scouts are needed to help artists load their artwork into and out of their booths on Friday and Sunday evening. These are the times (especially Sunday evening) when we are given tips for our services throughout the weekend.
