

First Aid Merit Badge 2010

I will offer the First Aid Merit Badge (MB) starting January 11. All Scouts who don't have the MB should take it. The first year scouts may not finish the MB, but should complete all of the Tenderfoot to First Class first aid requirements. Classes will be at TBC on Mondays:

Jan 11 - 6-7 pm MB requirement 1 -Tenderfoot and Second Class – first aid requirements

Jan 18 **no class**

Jan 25 – 6-7 pm MB requirement 1 - First Class – first aid requirements

Feb 1 - 6-7 pm MB Requirement 2 – including 2d the Home First Aid Kit

Feb 8 – 6-8 pm MB Requirements 3 a-c CPR w/manikin

Feb 15 – 6-7 pm MB Requirements 4 a,b and 6 a,b – hands-on bandages, splints, and carries

Feb 22 – 6-7 pm MB Requirements 3d,e & 5a-j

Mar 1 – 6 pm Requirement 7 and Exam

The MB **is not** finished until Requirement 2d – Home First Aid Course is presented and the Exam and CPR passed.

Requirement 2d – Home First Aid Kit – will be explained with a demonstration of the items needed in Feb 1 class – the items to be included are listed on p 22 of the MB book. Parents are encouraged to attend the Feb 1 class to see the items in the kit. I have mouth barriers, goggles, and gloves for sale.

Materials: Your Boy Scout Handbook – 2009 edition

First Aid Merit Badge book – 2007 edition, 2004 edition is not valid anymore
