Medications

All prescription medication must come to camp in the original bottle from the pharmacy.

The label must contain:

- The Camper's Name
- Date of prescription
- Doctor's name and phone number
- Correct dosage

No handwriting will be allowed on prescription medication bottles.

All over the counter medication must come to camp in the original containers.

The taking of prescription medication is the responsibility of the individual taking the medication and/or that individual's parent/guardian. A Scout leader, after obtaining all the necessary information, can agree to accept the responsibility of making sure a Scout takes the necessary medication at the appropriate time, BSA policy does not mandate nor necessarily encourage the Scout leader to do so.

All Prescription medication must be accompanied by a note from a parent or legal guardian giving permission for the medication to be administered by the Scout leader or Health Officer at camp.
